

**Holmes County Teachers' Association**  
**Scholarship Application Form & Qualifications**  
**Deadline: May 5, 2023 – 3:00pm**

1. The applicant must be a graduating senior from a high school in Holmes County.
2. Proof of a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale must be presented.
3. Applicant must submit three letters of recommendation as follows: one each from a teacher, a community leader, and a non-family member.
4. A copy of the high school transcript showing SAT or ACT scores must be submitted with the application.
5. Proof of acceptance at a college, university, or vocational school must be submitted with the application. (This will not keep you from receiving the scholarship, if you don't have one yet.)
6. **Three (3) copies** of an essay not to exceed three (3) typed, double-spaced pages explaining the applicant's educational and career goals as well as his or her need for the scholarship must be attached to the application. **Do not** fax these applications.
7. In the case of a tie, finalists may be interviewed by an impartial committee whose members have no relation to the applicant. The decision of the Scholarship Committee will be final.
8. The scholarship will be awarded to a child of an HCTA member who has been in the association for at least one full year.

**Payment of scholarship**

The amount of the scholarship totals \$1,000.00 to be paid \$500.00 per semester for 2 semesters. This award will be paid upon receiving a receipt for each semester. This award will be canceled if the student withdraws from school, and if withdrawal is for any reason other than illness, funds expended by HCTA will be refunded to the organization on a pro-rated basis.

**Scholarship will not be announced until presented at that senior's graduation ceremony.**
